## Church Snow Policy



Due to continued snowy weather and questions from church members, the Deacons decided to put into effect the following church cancellation policy:

### Sunday Morning

Both Sunday morning services will always meet, regardless of the weather. Services will be held for those in attendance. The only exception is in the event the Governor declares a state of emergency.

### Sunday Evening

Sunday evening services may be canceled by the Pastor and the Deacon Chair if they consider the weather a liability to the membership.

### Wednesday Evening

Wednesday evening cancellation will follow the Putnam County School policy. If schools are closed due to bad weather, there will be no Wednesday evening programs.



### Boards and Committees

Board and Committee Chairs will make individual decisions regarding cancellation.
